

# condom fact sheet



- Condoms need to be stored in cool, dry and dark conditions.
- Condoms that are past their sell by date will be used for demonstration purposes only.
- There should be between 8 and 10 condom in each bag. Instructions need to be included and the bags sealed with an Undercover label.

## Issues to cover during a condom demonstration:

- European CE sign and expiry date
- Be careful if wearing jewellery
- Make sure hands are washed
- How to open the packaging/making sure there are no rips or tears
- Squeezing the teat, to exclude air until condom is fully unrolled
- Make sure condom is not inside out (if it is the wrong way round throw it away and start again) and is rolled down to the base of the demonstrator
- Provide information about appropriate water based lubricants
- Put the condom on before sexual contact
- Withdraw as soon as man has ejaculated before penis goes soft, holding base of condom so semen does not leak out
- Check for splits
- Disposal – Wrap condom in tissue and put in bin, do not flush down the toilet
- Use another condom for further sexual contact
